## **Research interests**

I specialise in (critical) discourse analysis, media discourse, rhetoric and practical argumentation. I have done research in several areas: discursive representation and identity construction, especially in the media (with a focus on intra-EU migrant identities and ethnic identities); the construction of public problems in contexts of policy-making, in the spheres of migration, gender and the environment; discursive practices of media advocacy and public debate; discourse and discrimination; discourse and power. My scientific contributions include theoretical insights, as well as methodological and empirical work, in the following areas: processes of re-signification, symbolic boundary-drawing and claim-making within practices of public debate and of resistance; the enactment of advocacy and practical arguments in media dispositives; the role of discourse in the public (re)positionings and (dis)empowerment of various social and institutional actors (Romanian intra-EU migrants, Romanian Roma, Romania as an EU member-state); the rhetoric of right-wing populist discourse; the incorporation of discourse into the theoretical and methodological study of transnational dynamics (joint work within the *Diaspora in the Romanian Media and Political Sphere* project).
