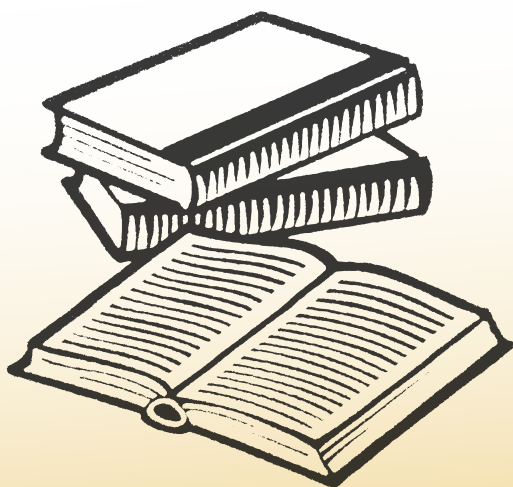

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PRESENTAZIONE DELLE ATTIVITÀ DI INSEGNAMENTO OFFERTA DALL'UNIVERSITÀ DELL'OVEST DI TIMISOARA PER IL POSTO DI VISITING PROFESSOR NELL'ANNO ACCADEMICO 2024-2025

La cattedra di italianistica, parte del Dipartimento di Lingue e Letterature Moderne presso l'Università dell'Ovest di Timisoara, propone per un periodo di 4 mesi una posizione di Visiting professor specializzato in lingua, letteratura, cultura e civiltà italiana. Il candidato dovrebbe insegnare agli studenti di laurea triennale e laurea magistrale.

I corsi disponibili nell'ambito dell'italianistica sono:

Lingua italiana (II anno, corso e seminario di laurea triennale):

- lezioni frontali di lingua italiana destinato agli studenti del secondo e/o terzo anno della laurea triennale in Lettere (nel secondo semestre, corsi e seminari e/o laboratori di glottodidattica). Il corso è articolato in attività focalizzate sullo sviluppo linguistico: attività di glottodidattica della lingua italiana che prevedono lo studio teorico di parti della morfologia e approfondito durante il seminario tramite esercizi mirati a chiarire le eventuali difficoltà per gli studenti.

Valori universali della letteratura e della cultura italiana (corso e seminario, MSR II anno):

- lezioni frontali completate da una bibliografia selezionata che intende soffermarsi su autori rappresentativi della letteratura italiana, nonché del panorama culturale della penisola.

Dinamica del lessico italiano (corso e seminario, MSR II anno):

- lezioni frontali sull'evoluzione e l'adattamento del vocabolario, ai continui cambiamenti della società. Il corso focalizza settori specifici ai linguaggi settoriali, per rispondere alle esigenze di comunicare in modo preciso in ciascun settore. Questi lessici arricchiscono la lingua con nuovi termini, con nuovi significati per parole preesistenti e quindi analizzando la complessità di comunicazione e di adattamento alle nuove realtà

Corso pratico (II anno, laurea triennale):

- il laboratorio si articola in lezioni frontali che mirano la comunicazione scritta e orale, per sviluppare e consolidare le competenze comunicative degli studenti. I temi saranno scelti e adeguati al livello di conoscenza della lingua italiana degli studenti, con ascolto, lettura, scrittura, parlato di testi autentici, ed è articolato in base ai diversi livelli linguistici del QCER.

PRESENTATION OF THE ACADEMIC TEACHING POSITION OFFERED BY THE WEST UNIVERSITY OF TIMISOARA FOR THE POSITION OF VISITING LECTURER IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2024-2025

The chair of Italian Studies, part of the Department of Modern Languages and Literatures of the West University of Timisoara, offers the position of Visiting Lecturer specialized in Italian language, literature, culture and civilization for a period of 4 months. The candidate should teach bachelor and master's degree students.

The courses available in the Italian field are:

Italian language (2nd year, course and seminar of bachelor degree):

- face-to-face lectures in Italian language for students in the second and/or third year of the bachelor's degree in Letters (in the second semester, courses and seminars and/or language teaching laboratories). The course is structured in activities focused on linguistic development: Italian language teaching activities that include the theoretical study of parts of the morphology and further analyzed during the seminar through exercises aimed at clarifying any difficulties for students.

Universal values of Italian literature and culture (course and seminar, master MSR 2nd year):

- face-to-face lectures completed by a selected bibliography which intends to focus on representative authors of Italian literature as well as the cultural panorama of the peninsula.

Dynamics of the Italian lexicon (course and seminar, MSR 2nd year):

- face-to-face lectures on the evolution and adaptation of vocabulary to the continuous changes in society. The course focuses on specific sectors and sectorial languages, to meet the needs of communicating precisely in each sector. These lexicons enrich the language with new terms, with new meanings for pre-existing words and therefore analyzing the complexity of communication and adaptation to new realities.

Practical course (2nd year, bachelor degree):

- the laboratory is divided into face-to-face lectures that focus on written and oral communication in order to develop and consolidate the communication skills of the students. The themes will be chosen and adapted to the students' level of knowledge of the Italian language, with listening, reading, writing and speaking authentic texts, and is structured according to the different linguistic levels of the CEFR.
